

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Girls: Years 1-6

Tartan Skort, short sleeve navy polo with school logo. Option of long sleeve navy polo with school Logo for winter.

Years 7-8

Navy Skort, white blouse with school logo, option of long sleeve white shirt for winter.
Socks Navy tights or knee-high socks.

Boys: Year 1-6

Grey elastic waist shorts and navy polo with school logo, option of long sleeve navy polo with school logo for winter.

Years 7-8

Grey classic shorts, short sleeve grey shirt, with school logo, option of long sleeved grey shirt for winter.

Socks - Grey knee-high socks.

Unisex:

Grey long trousers - maroon school HAT, with school logo - maroon/white SPORT TOP, with school logo - Black SPORT SHORT, with school logo - Maroon POLAR FLEECE, with school logo - Black JACKET, with school logo.

Footwear:

Summer – Black or Brown sandals (plain).

Winter – Black school shoes. NO canvas, chucks, vans AFI's etc

Physical Education:

Black SPORTS SHORTS and Maroon/white SPORT TOP with school Logo.

Hair Styles:

Hair must be tidy, simple, and of natural colour (as determined by the principal).

“ Prohibited hairstyles include (but are not limited to):

- Rat's tails
- Mohawks
- Dreadlocks
- Patterns or designs shaved into the hair.
- Long hair (hair that reaches the collar) must be tied back, off the face, and fringes must not cover the students' eyes or require regular adjustments. This applies to both boys and girls.
- Parents may apply to the principal for an exemption from these restrictions for their child, on the grounds that the hairstyle is culturally significant.

- Hair ties must be coloured maroon, navy, or black.

Sun-hats: All children are to have a regulation school sun-hat which will be worn as part of the summer school uniform, and is to be worn at school during interval and lunch times, going to the town pools.

Change of Season: Summer - Beginning of 4th Term

Winter - Beginning of 2nd Term

Jewellery:

Students may wear one pair of stud earrings, a watch, cross and chain, and/or necklaces of religious or cultural significance to the individual.

Breach of the dress code:

- Parents must inform the class teacher or principal in writing if their child cannot wear the regulation school uniform. The principal has been delegated discretionary responsibilities by the board of trustees to alter the uniform guidelines for valid individual cases.
- If no reason has been given for the wearing of incorrect uniform, the principal will request an explanation from the student's parents.
- Any continued infringement of the policy after the above will result in parents being contacted immediately by the principal and asked to visit the school to discuss the matter.
- If no decision can be made, the parents will be referred to the board where the board will decide what further action will be taken.
