

(Attendance) Parent/Guardian and student responsibilities (School Docs)


Parents and guardians have legal obligations to ensure their children attend school (Education and Training Act, s 244). We expect parents/guardians to:

- Notify the school as soon as possible if their child is going to be late or absent
- Arrange appointments and trips outside school hours or during school holidays where possible work with the school to manage attendance concerns.
- We share attendance expectations with students and their parents and caregivers and require students to be present and attend classes on time. Parents/Guardians may ask for their child to be excused from certain areas of the curriculum (Health Education) for religious or cultural reasons. The principal reviews these requests and considers the preferences of the student. The school provides supervision for any students who do not participate in certain areas of the curriculum.
