

Kia ora koutou e te whānau,

Welcome back to Term 2! I hope you are all well and ready for another exciting term of learning.

Over the past three terms, we have been reviewing our **Behaviour Management Guidelines**, and we are now at a stage where we need to gather feedback from parents. In the coming weeks, I will be reaching out to the parent community to collect your thoughts and input.

Parents and students were surveyed in Terms 3 and 4 of 2024, and the data from these surveys, along with feedback from teachers, has been collated to help shape the final document. This will be shared with the community towards the end of the term.

A summary of the parent survey was shared with the community in **Week 9 of Term 4, 2024**, and this has been instrumental in guiding the next steps. Based on the survey feedback, we have been focusing on areas such as **rewards for positive behaviour** and **increasing communication about the behaviour management system**—both of which were common themes that emerged from the survey results.

As part of the next steps, we introduced **ClassDojo points** for each class and began rewarding positive behaviours throughout Term 1, 2025. Students work hard each week to earn ClassDojo points, and the top 3 students in each class are recognised at the end of the week during assembly. The highest ClassDojo point scorer receives a certificate and a small prize, while the other top scorers also receive a small prize.

In Term 2, classrooms have been using **Toots** and **Hocs** as part of our behaviour management system. More information will be shared with you soon, but in the meantime, you may want to ask your children about it to gauge their understanding.

Thank you for your ongoing support as we work to refine and improve our behaviour management practices.

Progress interviews and Mid-Year Reports - Towards the end of the Term - Finer details to come.


